As you may already know, Mount Ida College has partnered with [EverFi](#), whose mission is to help students address critical life skills such as alcohol abuse prevention, sexual assault prevention, and financial literacy in higher education institutions across the country. Each year over 1,500,000 students and employees complete these courses.

As part of our comprehensive prevention program for new students, Mount Ida College **expects you to complete AlcoholEdu, Haven, and Transit**. This online education will empower you to make well-informed decisions about issues that affect your years at Mount Ida College and beyond. These courses are **REQUIRED** for full-time students and **RECOMMENDED** for part-time students.

All courses will be available starting August 8th, 2017.

PLEASE READ THE FOLLOWING CAREFULLY:

You are expected to complete **AlcoholEdu, Haven, and Transit**. You will need one EverFi Higher Education Account to access the course(s) from your dashboard.

To fulfill Mount Ida College's requirement:

- Go to: <http://www.everfi.com/login> and click **Register**
- Under "Student/Learner", enter the Registration Code **6123f3f9** to create your EverFi Account
- Complete Part 1 of all courses by September 4th.
- After 45 days you will receive an invitation to complete Part 2 of AlcoholEdu, Haven, and Transit which must be completed by October 30th, 2017.

*If you already have an EverFi Higher Ed Account, go to <http://www.everfi.com/login>, enter your login information, then enter registration code **6123f3f9** by clicking "Add a Course" in the top right corner of the Dashboard.

Other Important Information:

- You will need Internet access and audio capabilities.
- To avoid technical issues, please use any major web browser (e.g., Firefox, Internet Explorer, Google Chrome) released within the previous two years.
- You may take the course in multiple sittings.
- The course may include surveys to help personalize your experience and measure participants' attitudes and behaviors. All survey responses are confidential; the school will only receive information about the participant group as a whole and will never see individual answers.
- Should you experience problems, technical support is available 24/7 and can be accessed from the "Help" link within the course.
